About EFTPS

The Electronic Federal Tax Payment System (EFTPS) is a free service from the U.S.

Department of the Treasury. Since it began in 1996, millions of businesses, individuals, federal agencies, tax professionals, and payroll services have used EFTPS. All federal taxes can be paid using EFTPS. You can make payments via this Web site, a voice response system, or special channels designed for tax professionals, payroll services, and financial institutions. Quick, secure, and accurate, EFTPS is available by phone or online 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. You can schedule business and individual payments up to 365 days in advance.

Please note: The IRS and the Financial Management Service (the Treasury bureau that owns EFTPS) do not communicate payment information through e-mail. So don't ever click on an email that refers to the EFTPS system.

Convenience at your fingertips

- Schedule payments up to 365 days in advance
- Make your tax payment from home or office, 24/7
- Pay your income, employment, estimated and excise federal tax payments
- Easily change or cancel scheduled payments
- Track your payment with email notifications
- View 15 months of payment history
- Receive help with payments or questions from Customer Service Agents
- Payments have to be made a day before the payment is due



STEPS TO SET UP THE ACCOUNT

1. FILL OUT THE ONLINE EFTPS APPLICATION (SEE BELOW LINK)
2. WAIT FOR THE IRS TO MAIL YOU A PIN/ENROLLMENT NUMBER NOTICE (MAILED TO ADDRESS ON RECORD WITH THE IRS). THIS SHOULD TAKE ABOUT 5 DAYS.
3. ONCE YOU RECEIVE THE PIN/ENROLLMENT NUMBER NOTICE, CLICK ON THE BELOW LINK ONCE AGAIN
4. CHOOSE "MY PROFILE" FROM TOP TOOLBAR
5. CHOOSE "NEED A PASSWORD"
6. FILL OUT SCREEN INFO
7. CREATE PASSWORD
8. ACCOUNT SHOULD THEN BE READY TO USE

New to our site?
The Electronic Federal Tax Payment System® tax payment service is provided free by the U.S. Department of the Treasury. After you've enrolled and received your credentials, you can pay any tax due to the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) using this system.

You asked, we listened!
The EFTPS® Web site was recently updated based on feedback from users like you. You can now:

- Receive your confirmation by email.
- Verify the bank account that will be used when making a payment
- Change the bank account used for a payment
- Self-select your PIN when creating an additional enrollment
- Terminate an enrollment you are no longer using

Please note: Your tax payment is due regardless of this Web site's availability. You can always make a tax payment by calling our voice response system at 1.800.555.3453. Follow the prompts to make your payment.

What You Need to Know

- The IRS continues to remind taxpayers to watch out for email schemes. Taxpayers will only receive an email from EFTPS if they have opted in for email notifications when they sign up for email through EFTPS. Report all unsolicited email claiming to be from the IRS or an IRS-related function to phishing@irs.gov.
- You must be enrolled to use the EFTPS® tax payment service. To enroll, click on Enrollment at the top of this page and follow the steps. If this is your first time enrolling in EFTPS®, your information will need to be validated with the IRS. After this process is complete you will receive a personal identification number (PIN) via U.S. Mail in five to seven business days at your IRS address of record.
- Payments using this Web site or our voice response system must be scheduled by **8 p.m. ET the day before the due date** to be received timely by the IRS. The funds will move out of your banking account on the date you select for settlement.
- This EFTPS® tax payment service Web site supports Microsoft Internet Explorer for Windows, Google Chrome for Windows and Mozilla Firefox for Windows.

If you are setting up an account for a Trust, choose Business.

PRIVACY ACT AND PAPERWORK REDUCTION ACT NOTICE

We ask for the information on the forms on EFTPS.com and EFTPS.gov to carry out the Internal Revenue laws of the United States. We need this information to ensure that you are complying with the revenue laws and to allow us to figure and collect the right amount of tax. Our authority to ask for this information is 5 U.S.C. 301 and Internal Revenue Code sections 6001, 6011, 6012, and their applicable regulations. Section 6109 requires filers to provide their SSN or other identifying numbers. The information will be used to enroll you

Stop! If you used a coupon in the past two years or if your business is less than a year old, you are pre-enrolled in EFTPS. Please locate the four-digit Personal Identification Number (PIN) that was mailed to you and call 800.555.3453 to activate your enrollment. You'll need your banking information to do so. If you can't find your PIN and have not already completed your enrollment, call 888.434.7338 and your PIN will be given to you. If you choose instead to create a new enrollment in EFTPS by completing the form on this page, it will be five to seven business days before you receive your PIN in the mail and can schedule a payment.



- Must contain at least one uppercase letter (A, B, C, etc.)

- Must contain at least one of the following characters (!, @, #, \$, *, +, -)
- Must not contain double characters (no two consecutive characters can be the same)
